Accessibility Statement

1. Introduction

This statement was last updated on June 15, 2026. RDP Consultants ("RDP," "we," "us," or "our") is committed to ensuring that our website, www.rdp-usa.com (the "Site"), is accessible to people with disabilities.

2. What Web Accessibility Is

An accessible website allows visitors with disabilities to navigate, understand, and interact with its content with the same or a similar level of ease as other visitors. This is achieved through the underlying design and code of the Site, in combination with assistive technologies such as screen readers, screen magnifiers, voice recognition software, and keyboard-only navigation.

3. Our Accessibility Standard and Ongoing Efforts

We have worked to adapt this Site in substantial conformance with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.1, Level AA — the standard generally recognized by the U.S. Department of Justice and California courts as the benchmark for website accessibility under the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and California's Unruh Civil Rights Act.

As part of this effort, we have:

- Set a defined language for the Site so assistive technologies can correctly interpret content
- Structured page content in a logical reading and navigation order
- Used clear, hierarchical heading structures across all pages
- Added descriptive alternative text to images, including site photography and figures
- Implemented color combinations that meet WCAG-required contrast ratios
- Minimized non-essential motion and animation on the Site
- Designed page elements to be operable using a keyboard alone, without requiring a mouse

Accessibility is an ongoing effort. We periodically review the Site and make updates as we identify opportunities for improvement or as accessibility standards evolve.

4. Third-Party Content

RDP does not control the accessibility of this third-party content, and our efforts described above do not extend to systems outside our direct control.
